# Cub Scout Leader Basic Training:

Introduction to Cub Scouts , How To Have Fun, and Position Specific  
Saturday, September 18, 2010 (9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.)



**Location and directions:** PLEASANT HILL FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH, 2115 Pleasant Hill Road (about halfway between Gregory Lane and Oak Park Boulevard, on the west side of the street) in Pleasant Hill. There is ample, free parking in the church lot, but you may also park on the residential streets for no cost.

**Who should be trained?** This is basic training for all registered adult leader positions in Cub Scouting.

**What do I have to do to be considered “fully trained” and earn my *Trained* uniform patch?**

- **Fast Start (FS)** Current Position complete online prior to arrival – bring certificate of completion
- **Youth Protection (YP)** complete online prior to arrival – bring certificate of completion
- **This is Scouting (TIS)** complete online prior to arrival – bring certificate of completion
- **Position Specific (PS)** Only available LIVE at Position Specific Trainings like this one

**What is Cub Scout Leader Basic Training?** The leader basic training covers the very basics of the Cub Scout program and how cub scouts have fun. This course is broken down into two main sections:

**Introduction to Cub Scouts and How To Have Fun:** attend live from 9:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

**Position Specific (PS) breakout sessions:** attend live from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

**Already “Trained” for your prior Cub Scout leader position?** There is no need to attend the full Cub Scout Leader Basic Training. For a discount price of **\$10.00**, you can just attend the “live” Position Specific (PS) breakout session for your new position. You need to bring proof that you have completed previous training. The start time is **11:00 a.m.** – **please arrive at 10:45 a.m. to check in.**

**NOTE: if you are already trained,** you do not need to retake online **This Is Scouting.** However, you may need to retake online **FS** (Cubmaster, Den Leader, or Pack Committee) if your role has changed, and **Youth Protection (YP)** if it has been two years since the last training.
