

SCOUT UNIT INFORMATION FOR 2010 9-11 CEREMONY

PLEASE NOTE TIME CHANGE THIS YEAR

Time: Scouts will need to arrive in uniform and on time for parking and to get to the assembly area between 9:15 and 9:30 at the latest. Remember Friday morning traffic can be heavier so plan departure accordingly.

Scout part of the Ceremony starts at 9:50 AM

Expectations:

- Scouts and Leaders should be in uniform
- Only U.S. flags provided by the Exchange Club will be used
- Scouts need to act as adults during the ceremony

Parking: Parking is available at both of the Monte Vista high School lots, located on Stone Valley Road adjacent to the park

Assembly Area: Units will all assemble and check in at the small picnic area midway between the memorial and the clubhouse. An adult or senior scout representative from each unit will report to the coordinator for instructions and flag issue. At approximately 9:45 AM we will move to the base of the healing path walkway and ready for a 9:50 entrance

Timeline:

- 9:15-9:30 Scouts arrive, organize, are briefed and are issued flags
- 9:45 Scout units assemble on line prior to Program Start
- 9:50 On Piper queue, Scout units with American flags march single file to form a semi-circle at the rear of the program area and remain in place until program end
- 10:00 Program Starts – Scouts stand fast with the flags during the program
- 10:50 Program ends and Scouts on cue march back to staging area, turn in flags, and head off for ice cream to the designated area

Safety: Please, no running to, from or in the park
The flags may get heavy for the smaller scouts and adult assistance with the flags may be necessary

Post Ceremony:

Scouts are invited to ice cream afterwards
